Students' work is graded out of 20 points, **for international students the lowest passing mark being 08/20**. Grades may be awarded for midterm and/or final examinations, individual and/or group papers and reports, presentation and class participation.

Most grades are a mix of several of these types of assessment.

Credit is transferred for classes where the student obtained a grade of 8 or 9 **only if their GPA is of 10 or over**
