

International Flash Fiction Competition: Rules and Regulations

- 1. This competition is open to all students registered at the Université Catholique de Lille or one of its partner universities for the academic year 2021-22.
- 2. All participants should write in a language other than their native language (it is possible to enter texts in two different languages)
- 3. The languages for this competition are English, French, German and Spanish.
- 4. Participants should submit an original story or poem of 200 to 500 words on the theme "Tomorrow's World".
- 5. Participants should write their full name, university, native language and email address at the top of their entry and the number of words at the end.
- 6. The student who wishes to participate should send their text between 15 October 2021 and 15 March 2022 to the email address: flashfiction@univ-catholille.fr
- 7. A long list, based on the quality of the language, will be compiled for the jury.
- 8. The number of winning entries in each language will be proportional to the number of texts received, but will be at least three and at most twelve.
- 9. The names of the winners will be announced in a hybrid ceremony on 7 June 2022 at 6pm (French time).
- 10. The winning stories for each language will be published in paper form and online together with stories from guest authors. All winning students will receive a copy of the book.
